



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update

Vaccine registration open to all Vogtle 3&4 workers

The Vogtle 3&4 site has been notified of eligibility to receive doses of Johnson and Johnson's Janssen COVID-19 vaccine, which only requires recipients to receive one shot.

On-site appointments to receive the vaccination will be available from 10 a.m.- 8 p.m., April 7, 8, 14 and 15. If you would like to receive the vaccination, please use the links below to register for an appointment.

Appointment registration will remain open until the following deadlines or until all registration spots have been filled. The deadline to register for appointments on April 7 and April 8 is **Tuesday, April 6**. For appointments on April 14 and April 15, the deadline to register is **Tuesday, April 13**.

Appointments are on a "first-come, first-serve" basis. If you are unable to secure an appointment time, please use the "waiting list" link below to indicate you would like to be contacted if an appointment becomes available. Please note, we are unable to predict if or when the Vogtle 3&4 project will receive additional COVID-19 vaccinations and encourage workers interested in receiving the vaccine on-site to register using the links below. If you have received or are scheduled to receive the vaccine through other means or do not need/want the vaccine, simply ignore this message.

To register for an appointment, you will need:

- Your Vogtle 3&4 construction badge number
- For SNC employees ONLY – your six-digit company ID
- An email address – does not need to be a company email address

Please only reserve one appointment time and provide ALL requested information in the registration link. Space is limited, and you should only register if you are sure you can make the appointment.

To complete your registration, click "Save," in the blue box at the top of the screen. You should receive an email confirmation after you have successfully registered.

Vaccines will be administered in Building 130 (see attached map for reference). If you register for an appointment, you must complete and sign the attached consent form and bring it with you to the appointment.

We believe that vaccines play an essential role in protecting the health of our workers and the communities we serve; therefore, we have partnered with PointMed, a medical group practice, in an effort to make vaccines available, as supply and state guidelines permit.
